

ODDS BOARD

Each dog is listed by number on the odds board. The odds, posted next to his number change before the race, based upon the amount of money being bet on each dog. If a dog is a favorite, more bets are placed on him and the odds are lower. If there are only a few bets on a dog the odds on him are higher. Dogs with lower odds win more often than dogs with higher odds. After the race the odds board will show the winners and payoffs. The odds board is operated automatically by computer.

NEVER THROW YOUR TICKET AWAY until the Race is OFFICIAL.

MUTILATED TICKETS: Try to avoid tearing or crumpling your tickets as they will not then pass through the payoff slot of the machine. Mutilated tickets must be cashed manually, which takes longer.

MINIMUM BETS: \$1 on Trifecta Boxes, Keys or Wheels; \$2 on Trifectas, Quinellas, Win, Place and Show.

Payoffs on single bets at odds of 300 to 1 or more must be made at special windows designated as IRS Windows.

WRONG TICKETS: "Any claim by a person that a wrong ticket has been delivered to them must be made prior to the top bet command being issued for the race for which the wrong ticket was sold." Rule 61 -D- 7.020(8). This means tickets cannot be changed or cancelled once wagering on that race has been stopped. The Track will not honor wrong tickets.

WAGERING

A QUICKER, EASIER WAY TO BET

When you cash a winning ticket, the display window will show the amount of your winnings. You may bet against this amount. When you have finished betting, the display window will show what the terminal operator owes you, or what you owe the terminal operator.

EXAMPLE:

You win the second race Trifecta it pays \$125.00, when your winning ticket is placed in the machine the lighted display window shows \$125.00, you now call out your bets for the third race, let's say they total \$50.00, the lighted display window now shows you to receive \$75.00 plus your tickets for the third race.

SELF-SERVICE TERMINAL (SST)

The state-of-the-art in wagering systems . . . Self-Service Wagering. You place your own bets with either cash or betting vouchers you have previously purchased from manned terminals. If you follow the directions, Self Service Wagering is simple and fun. Don't forget to return the Balance Key (your change).

BET/CASH

CALL FOR YOUR BET IN THIS ORDER

- 1 - Track
- 2 - Dollar Amount
EXAMPLE: Two Dollars to win on number 6
- 3 - Type of Bet
- 4 - Dog numbers
EXAMPLE: \$1.00 Trifecta Box on the 2-4-6 dogs
Total Cost \$6.00

ATM MACHINES

ATM machines are located on the 1st Floor, 1st Mezzanine and Clubhouse area.

THE BASIC BETS

WIN-PLACE-SHOW

WIN = 1ST

Wager on the greyhound that will *win the race*. If your greyhound is 1st, you win the amount shown under "Win" on the tote board.

PLACE = 2ND

Wager on the greyhound that will finish *at least second*. If your greyhound is 1st or 2nd, you win the amount shown under "Place" on the tote board.

SHOW = 3RD

Wager on the greyhound that will finish *at least third*. If your greyhound is 1st, 2nd or 3rd, you win the amount shown under "Show" on the tote board.

QUINIELA (KWIN-EL-LA)

This is a popular bet at the track. The object is to pick two greyhounds who will finish first and second *in either order*. If you bet the 4-5 *you win* if the results are 4-5 or 5-4. This bet will usually pay more than a win bet.

QUINIELA BOX

Increases your chances of winning. You pick three greyhounds two of whom will finish First and Second *in either order* and *you win*. If you Box the 3-4-5 you have three bets 3-4, 3-5 and 4-5. Any of those combinations finishing First and Second, in either order, that is 3-4 or 4-3, 4-5 or 5-4, etc., and *you are a winner*. Ask the teller for a Quiniela Box and give your 3 numbers. Ask for the numbers in order, lowest 1st.

THE \$2.00 QUINIELA BOX

- 3-Dog Box (3 combinations) cost \$6
- 4-Dog Box (6 combinations) cost \$12
- 5-Dog Box (10 combinations) cost \$20
- 6-Dog Box (15 combinations) cost \$30

TWIN-TRI

The first half of this two-part exchange bet requires you to select the Race-5 Trifecta. A winning ticket on the first half will entitle you to the Twin-Tri first half price and an exchange ticket to select the second half Race 7. The Twin-Tri Jackpot is capped at \$15,000. Jackpot will be given away every Thursday Evening Performance.

TRIFECTA

This bet gives you a chance to pick three greyhounds to finish First, Second and Third, *in exact order*. This is greyhound racing's most popular wager. The payoffs on Trifectas are frequently the largest at the track. If you pick 1-2-8, and the 1 is first, the 2 second and the 8 third then you win. Ask for the numbers in exact order. Minimum wager is \$2.00.

TRIFECTA BOX

(COST: \$6.00 MINIMUM)

If you pick the greyhounds who finish First, Second and Third, *in any order* you win if you purchased a Trifecta Box for \$6.00. By Boxing the 1-2-8 *you win* when the 1-2-8 finish, First, Second and Third *in any order*. Your \$1.00 Trifecta Box consists of 6 combinations on which you have bet a total of \$6.00. Your payoff will be the \$1.00 Trifecta price. *Ask for a \$1.00 Trifecta Box*.

You may wish to Box more than 3 dogs, you may Box as many as you like.

THE \$1.00 TRIFECTA BOX

- 3-Dog Box (6 combinations) cost \$6
- 4-Dog Box (24 combinations) cost \$24
- 5-Dog Box (60 combinations) cost \$60
- 6-Dog Box (120 combinations) cost \$120
- 7-Dog Box (210 combinations) cost \$210
- 8-Dog Box (336 combinations) cost \$336

TRIFECTA WHEEL

(COST: \$42.00)

In Wheeling a dog, select one dog to finish first or second or third. Your dog *must* finish in the position you have selected. For example if you want number 7 to finish first, you ask for a \$1.00 Trifecta Wheel ticket on No. 7 to *WIN*. If No. 7 wins, no matter which dogs finish 2nd or 3rd, you have a winning Trifecta Wheel ticket. If, however, you feel that your selection No. 7 will finish 2nd, ask for No. 7 to *PLACE*. If the No. 7 finishes in 2nd place, you have a winning Trifecta Wheel ticket, no matter which dogs finish 1st or 3rd. This same formula applies if you feel your selection No. 7 will show, or run 3rd. In an 8 dog race a Wheel ticket cost \$42.00. It is 42 \$1.00 bets and pays the \$1.00 Trifecta price. *Ask for a \$1.00 Trifecta Wheel*.

\$1 TRIFECTA KEY

- TRIFECTA KEY -

One or more numbers placed in win, place, or show position with other numbers in the other positions.

EXAMPLE:

No. 1 to win, with the 6, 7 and 8 to finish second or third. This bet with a \$1.00 base will cost \$6.00. *Ask for a \$1.00 Trifecta Key*.

TRI-SUPER BET

The Tri-Super is the ultimate in high payoff bets. You are required to pick the Trifecta (first three finishers) in the first half and pick the Superfecta (first four finishers in exact order) in the second half to share in the jackpot payoff. When you win the first half you collect a share of the split of that performance's Tri-super wagers and exchange your ticket for your second half selection at no charge. The Tri-Super is offered in the 9th and 11th races and will be capped at \$50,000.00. If there is no winning combination selected, the jackpot will be distributed to all holders of ticket in the first half of the Tri-Super Combination. The Tri-Super will be forced out every other Friday Evening

SUPERFECTA

The Superfecta is a high payoff wager requiring you to pick the first, second, third and fourth greyhounds in the EXACT order you selected them. Minimum wager is \$2.00.

THE SUPERFECTA BOX

(\$24 MINIMUM)

The Superfecta Box will place all of your selections in the Win, Place, Show and fourth place positions. If you place a \$1 Superfecta Box, 1-3-5 & 7, the total cost of your ticket is \$24. This Boxing procedure gives you 24 different combinations. When 1-3-5 & 7 finish first, second, third and fourth, in any order, you are a Superfecta winner.

\$1 SUPERFECTA BOX

- 4-Dog Box (24 combinations) cost \$24
- 5-Dog Box (120 combinations) cost \$120
- 6-Dog Box (360 combinations) cost \$360
- 7-Dog Box (840 combinations) cost \$840
- 8-Dog Box (1680 combinations) cost \$1680
