



A QUICKER, EASIER WAY TO BET

When you cash a winning ticket, the display window will show the amount of your winnings. You may bet against this amount. When you have finished betting, the display window will show what the terminal operator owes you, or what you owe the terminal operator.

EXAMPLE:

You win the second race Trifecta. It pays \$125. When your winning ticket is placed in the machine the lighted display window shows \$125. You now call out your bets for the third race. Let's say they total \$50. The lighted display window now shows you to receive \$75 plus your tickets for the third race.

SELF SERVICE TERMINALS (SST)

The state of the art in wagering systems... Self-Service Wagering. You place your own bets with either cash or betting vouchers you have previously purchased from manned terminals. If you follow the directions, Self-Service Wagering is simple and fun. Don't forget to return the Balance Key (your change).

SEASONAL PASS

Admission during live racing is just \$2. Our patrons can enjoy the option of purchasing a pass for the entire racing season (November to May) at a considerable discount. The Seasonal Pass is \$25. Patrons may also purchase a special VIP Parking Pass that allows you to park your car in the Clubhouse Premium Parking area for \$50.

SIMULCASTING

Simulcast horse racing daily from 11:30AM from the nation's leading thoroughbred tracks, including: Belmont, Aqueduct, Churchill, Calder, Gulfstream Park, Keeneland, Hollywood Park, Santa Anita, Fairgrounds, Monmouth, Tampa Bay, Arlington, Hawthorne, Turfway, Dover, Penn National, Philadelphia, Laurel, Saratoga and Del Mar.

Simulcast greyhound racing from Derby Lane, Flagler, Palm Beach and Jacksonville.

Harness racing from Yonkers, Meadowland and Pompano.

You can watch the racing from individual TV cubicles in the Clubhouse or from a table. The Daily Racing Form is available daily at the track in addition to programs from the simulcast tracks.

Triple Crown Races and Breeders' Cup - Horse racing fans can also watch and wager on the Preakness Stakes and the Belmont Stakes following the Kentucky Derby and Breeders' Cup.

TYPES OF BETS OFFERED

- WIN-PLACE-SHOW
- QUINIELA (KWIN-EL-LA)
- TWIN-TRI
- TRIFECTA
- SUPERFECTA

Each dog is listed by number on the odds board. The odds, posted next to his number, change before the race based upon the amount of money being bet on each dog. If a dog is a favorite, more bets are placed on him and the odds are lower. If there are only a few bets on a dog, the odds on him are higher. Dogs with lower odds win more often than dogs with higher odds. After the race, the odds board will show the winners and payoffs. The odds board is operated automatically by computer.

NEVER THROW YOUR TICKET AWAY until the race is OFFICIAL.

MINIMUM BETS: \$1 on Trifecta Boxes, Keys or Wheels; \$2 on Trifectas, Quinielas, Win, Place and Show. Payoffs on single bets at odds of 300 to 1 or more must be made at special windows designated as IRS Windows.
